Napoli, Amalfi Coast and Capri



This eleven-day tour offers some of Italy's

most spectacular sites. The tour starts in Napoli. With a private local guide we explore some of the most famous and interesting sites in the city. Next, we head south to the breathtaking Amalfi coast.



After spending one night in Paestum, we make our way to the beautiful village of Positano, where we stay for three nights. From here we visit many of the other jewels of the coast, such as Ravello,

and Amalfi. We do more than see the sights; we discover how local products are made, like the beautiful ceramics, fabulous Mozzarella di Bufala and scrumptious limoncello. We enjoy the area by land: we hike the coastline from far above the sea and explore the hillside villages that are adorned by bougainvillea and wisteria.

One day we take a private boat excursion from the coast to the island of Capri. This is the most famous of the islands in the area, and has been a tourist destination forever – in fact it was a holiday destination for Roman Emperors – and continues to be for celebrities today. We stay on the island for three nights, to thoroughly enjoy the jaw-dropping beautiful scenery: wild flowers, fragrant lemon groves, vineyards, seaside wonders, etc.

On our way back to Napoli, we explore and learn all about the infamous village of Pompeii. We have a private archeologist to guide us through the ruins and bring the village back to life through stories and descriptions. Our last dinner will be in Napoli and a transfer service to the airport the next morning will be arranged for all departures.

Day 1: Afternoon walking tour of Napoli– to catch a glimpse of and learn a little about some of the city's highlights. We will end the walking tour at a ristorante near the hotel. (dinner)

Day 2: Discover Napoli. Today we will make our way through the city, ending the day with a visit to the Royal Palace and enjoying one of Napoli's most famous dishes: pizza!

Day 3: We will travel south, to a special resort where we will spend one night. In the afternoon, you will have time to enjoy the amenities of the resort (beach, pool, etc). (Breakfast, lunch, dinner)

Day 4: Today we will witness the current activities and ancient history that make this area famous. We will start our day at an organic farm which produces mozzarella di Bufala. Here we will participate in the production of the cheese and yogurt and then enjoy a lunch of their own production. After lunch, we will travel to Paestum where we will visit we will temples from the 6^{th} century B.C. Afterwards we will take the ferry to Positano. (breakfast, lunch).

Day 5: Today will be a day dedicated to Positano. There is so much to do, from shopping, to hiking, to relaxing on the beach. We will gather for dinner at a special restaurant in the evening. Optional add-on cooking class. (breakfast, dinner).

Day 6: We will head out to Ravello, perched high on the mountain in the morning where we will visit some of the highlights of the village. Next, we will enjoy a light lunch and then hike down, through the gorge and prehistoric forest site. We will finish the hike in Amalfi and return to Positano by ferry, you will have the evening on your own. (breakfast, lunch)

Day 7: Today we will enjoy a private boat excursion to the island of Capri. We will have a tour around the island by sea – with time for swimming in beautiful coves. Lunch will be at a seaside spot. In the afternoon we will head to the top of the island to our hotel. For anyone not interested in the private boat, there is the option to take the ferry.(breakfast, lunch, dinner)

Day 8: Capri is both posh and dramatic ... it offers something for everyone! You will have the morning on your own to discover the island. In the afternoon we will visit some unique places the island has to offer and enjoy the views and nature that Capri has to offer. (breakfast, dinner)

Day 9: Capri is yours to enjoy! Head to a beach club, take a hike, relax at the pool, shop...(breakfast)

Day 10: We will depart Capri in the morning to head back to the mainland, have lunch and visit Pompeii with a private guide. Afterwards we will drive to Napoli. (breakfast, lunch, dinner)

Day 11: Everyone will go on their way after breakfast! Arrivederci! (breakfast)
